Clinical Documentation Standards

Documentation of the duration of the encounter and time spent face-to-face with the patient in interview and examination. Documentation of the originating site location and personnel. Components of a clinical encounter which should be documented include: Chief Complaint or Reason for Encounter. Referral Source. History of Present Illness.

B107. §482.61(a)(3) The reasons for admission must be clearly documented as stated by the patient and/or others significantly involved. Assessment of quality in psychiatric nursing documentation ...

Always use a chronologic documentation format, providing separate entries for each narrative item. Block charting, or charting that doesn't separate each activity by timed entry, doesn't provide a clear picture of the sequence of events surrounding the care of the patient.

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
